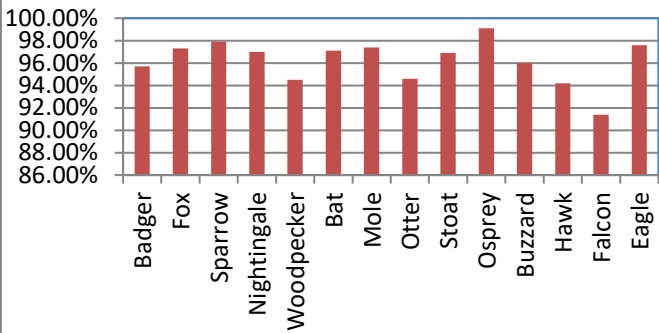
General Information
