A note from the Headteacher

Dear Parents,

Now that the weather is turning cooler in particular, thank-you for ensuring children are in the correct school uniform. We do understandably receive lots of questions from parents about school uniform and so I hope it is helpful to confirm the following:

Girls' uniform:

- School knitted cardigan (red with school logo)
- White blouse (long or short sleeve)
- School tie
- Grey skirt, pinafore or trousers (trousers should not be skinny-legged)
- Grey shorts (summer term)
- White/grey socks or grey tights
- Black school shoes
- Hair ties are plain red (no Jo-Jo bows or colourful hair hands)
- No jewellery except a watch and stud earrings

Boys' uniform:

- School knitted jumper (red with school logo)
- White shirt (long or short sleeve)
- School tie
- Grey school trousers (trousers should not be skinny-legged)
- Grey shorts (summer term)
- Grey school socks
- Black school shoes
- No jewellery except a watch and stud earrings

For PE we ask children to wear a polo shirt and shorts, both with the school logo on and either black or white trainers or plimsolls. If playing an outdoor activity, pupils can wear plain black jogging bottoms.

With wintery weather, please could we ask that children if wearing boots or wellies to school, that they have a pair of school shoes in their bags to change into on arrival.

If pupils have worn nail varnish over the weekend, please could this be removed in readiness for the start of the week.

All logo specific items can be purchased from our uniform supplier SANCO either online www.sanco.co.uk or visiting their shop at the address below: 60 Bell Rd, Town Centre, Hounslow TW3 3PB.

We do appreciate the financial investment required by parents in purchasing school uniform and so please do check in lost property should anything go missing or see one of the Senior Leadership Team, if costs are prohibitive.

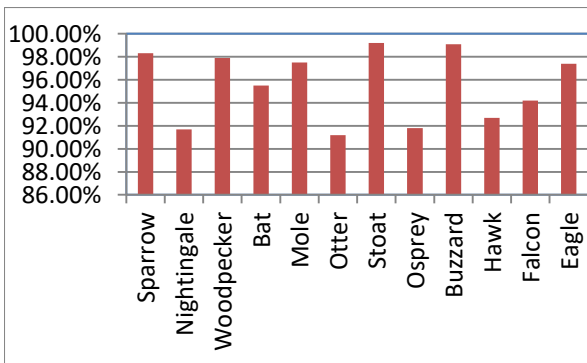

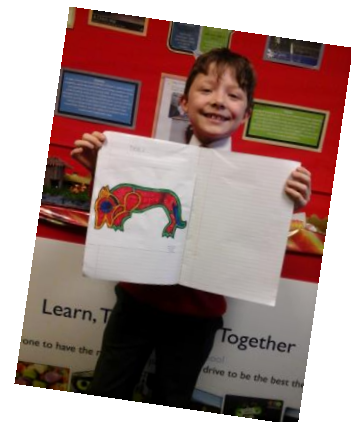
Home Learning Stars
