

For our children, it is important for the adults to understand that the internet has become an extension to many elements of their lives, learning, education, play and socialising.

Currently there is an app called '**TikTok**' (formerly musical.ly) This app appears to be the new trend among children around the world. It has been brought to our attention that some of the children in Springfield are active users and hold accounts.
